**House Keeping Issues:** Aurora is an AWESOME school and to keep it this way we need to take into account the concerns listed below:

- We have noticed an improvement in our parking lot during morning drop-offs. We realize that at the end of the day it is very congested in our traffic loop at pickup times. Student safety and following traffic laws are our highest priority. We have been noticing parents dropping off and picking up their children in the middle of the road, parents parking illegally on the sidewalk and on the grass.
