Our school's PreK program is held in its own classroom and taught by a certified teacher. Much like many early learning programs offered in Drayton Valley, we too require a monthly fee of \$100.00/month for registered students. There may be a subsidized fee offered for students with developmental delays or for those who required enhanced academic services.



Our PreK Program Offers many learning benefits such as:

- Quality instruction and play based learning
- Consistent exposure for your child to engage in a developmentally appropriate social-emotional and language rich environment

• Enhancement of your child's fine and gross motor skills, literacy and numeracy skills as well as emotional and social skills

- Help to facilitate in the development of independence, problem solving skills and fostering a sense of belonging and well-being in your child
  - Professional screening to ensure adequate support is provided in speech, language and motor skills
  - Access to programming support form a qualified Speech and Language Pathologist and Occupational Therapist

\*\*This program requires that there is a minimum of 18 students enrolled in the class by June 15 to operate beginning in September. This program is only available to children who are 4 years old by December 31, 2024.\*\*
